

ORDINANCES.

ORDINANCE NO 5912.—AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the herding of live stock within the city limits.

Be it ordained by the common council of Kansas City

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from herding hogs, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and cattle within the city limits.

Sec 2. Any person violating, neglecting or refusing to comply with this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

Sec 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are, in so much as they conflict with this ordinance, hereby repealed.
