

TO ENFORCE THE LAW.

The City Authorities Resolve to Come Down Hard on the Street Sweepers.

President Tiernan of the board of public works and Alderman Ed Hunter called on the mayor this morning to discuss ways and means for bringing the recalcitrant street sweepers to terms. The companies having the contracts for sweeping the business streets have been persistent, it is declared, in violating their contracts with the city. They have, it is said, swept the streets at hours forbidden and have conscientiously refused to sprinkle the thoroughfares, though the ordinance requires that streets shall be wet when swept.

It was unanimously agreed to require the police department to enforce the ordinance against sweepers who raise a dust. Chief Speers was accordingly instructed to see that the ordinance is enforced.
