

## **REWARDS FOR LYNCHERS.**

### **Governor Lewelling Offers State Money for the Saline Mob Members.**

TOPEKA, May 11.—Governor Lewelling this morning offered a reward of \$300 for the apprehension of the parties concerned in the lynching of Dan Adams, the negro, who stabbed the station agent of the Union Pacific at Salina a short time ago.

The Governor offered the reward in response to a demand by a committee of colored men who called upon him yesterday and presented him with a copy of resolutions adopted at an indignation meeting of colored people in this city Tuesday night, characterizing the lynching as a disgrace upon the state and as a painful manifestation of a wave of increasing prejudice, hatred and injustice now sweeping over the country against the negro race.
