Mayor Williard Will Call on the Citizens to Bring About a Change.

Mayor Williard and a few friends held a meeting yesterday to discuss the present situation of city affairs and the council's attitude toward his honor in the matter of making appointments to the various city offices. Mayor Williard has been in office nearly two months and efforts to secure the confirmation of any favorite has so far failed and yet his friends are making life a burden to him because he don't bring about a change.

Mr. Williard was advised yesterday to call mass meetings in each ward of citizens who are interested in the welfare of the government. It is proposed to adopt strong resolutions calling on the Councilmen to support the Mayor's appointments. The citizens who are behind Mr. Williard will be urged to storm the City hall at the next meeting of the Council and demand a change in the tactics pursued by the Council in fighting the Mayor's appointments.

At the Council meeting Monday night the name of Geddes Simmons for street commissioner was rejected by a vote of 5 to 1, and this action has aroused the public sentiment somewhat against the administration, and the two factions will commence to fight each other in dead earnest.
