

Williard Was Examined.

Mayor Frank Williard of Argentine was closeted in the county attorney's office all day yesterday and severely cross-questioned in regard to the running of joints in that city. A few days ago Mayor Williard handed County Attorney Cobb a list of fifty or more names of persons whom he claimed would give some damaging testimony against the various jointists. Cobb naturally supposed that Williard knew something himself, and had him subpoenaed.

The Mayor of Argentine was very closely questioned, but could give no information upon which the county attorney could issue a warrant. Williard could not even tell what the men whose names he furnished the attorney would testify to, and the county attorney was somewhat disappointed.
