

SUES FOR HEAVY DAMAGES.

**MRS. McILHINNY WANTS \$20,000 FROM
THE METROPOLITAN RAILWAY.**

**Claims to Have Been Crippled for Life
While Alighting From a Cable Car—Ex-
amination of Roland E. Bruner for
Fraudulent Use of the Mails—Harvey
Taylor Convicted the Third Time and
Given Fifteen Years for Criminal Assault
—The County Court Orders Various Tax
Rebates—Court Notes — Record of the
Circuit Court.**

Mrs. Ann McIlhinny began suit in the circuit court yesterday to recover \$20,000 from the Metropolitan Street Railway company, as damages for personal injuries. In her petition Mrs. McIlhinny claims that she boarded a Twelfth street car at McGee street on May 1 last. Arriving at Walnut street she signalled the conductor to stop the train, and started to leave the car. Just as she was stepping to the cross walk, however, the train was suddenly started, throwing her to the pavement and inflicting injuries that will cripple her for life. Accompanying the petition was an application to the court for permission to sue as a poor person.
