

A Gripman's Serious Injury.

Robert Dennison, a gripman for the Kansas City Cable railway company, was badly hurt at 1 o'clock this afternoon, at the corner of Eighth street and Troost avenue. His car was making the turn there when the handle of the grip-lever flew up and struck him on the left side of the face, causing a long gash and crushing the bone. He was taken from his car and was moved to his home, 3307 Troost avenue, in the police patrol wagon. He will probably recover, but will be scarred for life.
