

Running Without License.

Over 130 saloons are in full blast in Kansas City at present without city licenses and no steps have been taken to arrest the proprietors. With four exceptions all saloon licenses expired January 4, and applications for renewals of 359 of them were granted by the commissioners. Only 225 of the renewals have been taken out, but the unlicensed places are nevertheless doing a wide open business. When asked yesterday whether the police commissioners intended to take any steps to enforce the law, Police Secretary McGee said it was the duty of License Inspector Ahrens to act in the matter.
