

## RAID NORTH END SALOONS.

### The Police Take a Step to Prevent Further Highway Robberies.

The police fell on the cheap lodging houses and dives of the North end before daylight this morning and rounded up a score of men not too good to be highway robbers, and in police court this morning were given hours to leave the city. The raid was made because of the many cases of highway robbery during the past two weeks and this winter the North end lodging houses and saloons will be kept under close police surveillance.

Hugh Siler, alias John Ryan, who is said to be a burglar and whose face is in the rogues' gallery, was found asleep in a lodging house at 107 Delaware street. He was given hours to leave the city only last month, and so was arraigned and charged with vagrancy in police court.

"If you'll give me hours I'll leave the city," said Siler. This request is seldom asked by an honest man, and Judge Johnson looked at him closely.

"It will be no use to send me out to the work house, and let me out in the middle of the winter, for if you do I'll take something with me when I leave the town," the man continued.

"I like your frankness," said Judge Johnson. "The grass will be growing again when you leave the work house; \$100 fine, or 200 days."
