**HOOVER CUTS THE PRICE.**

**Gasoline Lights Will Now Cost the City \$19 Per Light Per Year.**

For the past few years the city has been paying Contractor F. K. Hoover \$21 a year for the maintenance of each of 1,100 gasoline lamps, which are located on street corners on the outskirts of the city where gas mains do not reach. It has been frequently urged by Mayor Cowherd and members of the gas committee of the Council that \$21 a year was an exorbitant price to pay for a gasoline lamp, and that steps should be taken by the city to buy and maintain its own lamps.

Yesterday Contractor Hoover appeared before a meeting of the gas committee and agreed to reduce the price to \$19 a year for each lamp. This will save the city about \$400 a month.
