

IN UNCLE SAM'S CUSTODY.

Yung Sing Must Tell How He Came to Possess Unstamped Opium.

Deputy United States Marshal Siddell yesterday arrested Yung Sing, the Chinaman who was taken in custody Thursday for running an opium den at 309 Walnut street, on charge of smuggling opium. The Chinaman was taken before United States Commissioner Nuckols and bound over to the Federal grand jury in the sum of \$500. He was given an opportunity to secure bail, but at the time the commissioner left his office the efforts to find security had been futile. Yung Sing's opium joint was raided by local officers and a quantity of opium was found. No government stamp appeared upon the boxes containing the opium and hence the charge of smuggling opium was brought.

Yung Sing, in default of bail, was last night confined in jail.
