

SCHOOL BOARD.

The Date of High School Commencement Formally Announced.

The regular meeting of the board of education was held at the public library building, corner of Eighth and Oak streets, last night. Accounts amounting to \$6,824.49 were allowed and warrants ordered. The secretary of the board filed a report of warrants issued, and the librarian submitted a report for the month of April, 1893.

The dates and places for holding the commencement exercises were fixed. The commencement exercises for the Central school will be held at the Auditorium, Wednesday, May 24, and the commencement exercises for Lincoln high school will be held at the Y. M. C. A. auditorium Thursday, May 25.

The following is a list of the graduates of the Lincoln high school to whom diplomas were ordered issued. Carrie Carter, Hattie Bozy, Sarah Frost, Dolly Yancy, Mabel Lucas, Frank Tucker and Eliza Williams.

A contract for curbing at Eleventh and Campbell streets was let to J. J. Dunn. The architect submitted plans for a two room addition to the Lowell school. The plan was approved and the architect instructed to receive bids for the construction thereof by the next meeting.

The enumeration of all persons of school age as made last year was readopted as follows: White males, 18,512; white females, 20,208; total whites, 39,020. Colored males, 1,868; colored females, 2,032; total colored, 3,900. Linwood district, now a part of this district, males, 65; females, 55. Grand total, 43,040.
