

## **TURNED THE TABLES.**

### **Garbage Contractor Skinner Makes Complaint Against Householders.**

Garbage Contractor Skinner is taking a hand in the complaint business himself. Heretofore it has been the residents who have heaped the desk of the assistant sanitary superintendent with complaints that the contractor did not remove their garbage. Yesterday the contractor filed with Dr. Waring a list of 137 names of householders who kept their garbage on the third or second floors of their residences and who complained that the contractor did not climb the stairs and remove the garbage from its place.

Mr. Skinner was instructed that he was not obliged to go higher than the first floor after garbage and that persons who did not have their garbage on the ground floor must remove their garbage at their own expense. Householders must also give the contractor access to the place where the garbage is kept. Otherwise he will not be required to remove it.

Contractor Skinner has put on three more wagons in addition to the complaint wagon. This gives thirty wagons in all, three in each ward and a rover in addition. The complaint wagon will be sent out to houses from which complaints come and every effort will be made to answer all complaints promptly. Householders are requested to telephone complaints to No. 2516, the office of the city physician, and they will be attended to with all possible celerity.
