

### Notes From the Street Markets.

Game is scarce.

Poor apples are about gone and fancy fruit is high.

The market is bare of trashy potatoes and the little good stock is selling quickly.

Home grown vegetables were abundant this morning and trade was active and strong.

Receipts of eggs are liberal and stocks are accumulating as trade is nearly all local. Prices are weak and eggs have to be candled and strictly choice to bring quotations; otherwise they are worth a half cent less.

The butter trade is in good condition. Receipts of country butter are larger, the quality is fair and demand is equal to the supply at steady prices. Creamery butter is selling slowly and declining, though not a great amount is coming.

The supply of poultry has been moderate for several days. Hens are wanted and firm. Turkeys are neglected and weak. It is useless to send little chicks here as they will not sell. Springs are quiet and range in price from \$2 to \$5 per dozen as to quality.

Strawberries were at a premium this morning. The market has been bare of good berries for several days and but a few cases came to-day. The fruit was better than usual and the demand was stronger than at any time this season. It was no trouble to get from \$3 to \$4.50 per case.
