

## A KANGAROO BOXER.

### He Will Give Exhibitions of the Fistic Art at Washington Park.

J. F. MacMahon of the firm of MacMahon Bros., the well known amusement enterprise managers of Sydney, Australia, who arrived here yesterday from Chicago, have arranged for a series of boxing exhibitions between the Kangaroo "Jack" and his trainer, to be given at Washington park, commencing tomorrow. The entertainment is said to be the highest priced novelty in the way of an individual attraction now in this country, and Mr MacMahon thinks it will create as big a sensation here as it did in San Francisco. The kangaroo is now 3 years old, stands over seven feet in height when in boxing position and weighs 156 pounds, and at each afternoon and evening performance will box four stiff rounds with John Tait, his trainer, who is the only man who has successfully trained these Australian wonders in the fistic art. The MacMahons have two of these kangaroos, the other being on exhibition at the Aquarium in London, England, where it was engaged for a year. "Jack" was landed at San Francisco in May, and is now under contract with Champion Corbett and Manager Brady and will join them in New York at the close of his engagement at Washington park. During his stay here he will give two exhibitions daily, at 5:30 and 8:30, respectively.

In addition to the beauties of Washington park and the special kangaroo attraction may be mentioned the boating and bathing privileges and the concerts which are given every afternoon and evening by the Washington park band.
