

The residence of J. M. Juvenal, 627 Third street, South side, was wrecked by dynamite on Monday night. At the time of the explosion Mr. Juvenal and his wife—to whom he has but recently been married—and his sister, Mrs. Rickets, of Excelsior Springs, and her two children were asleep in the house. The concussion awoke every person in the south side of the city. The house was badly wrecked but none of the inmates were injured. The explosion occurred at 11 o'clock p. m., and neighbors say a woman was seen entering the yard some fifteen minutes before. Juvenal swore out a warrant for Miss Millie Pfaffman, of Kansas City, Mo., to whom he was at one time engaged to be married. She was arrested at 4 o'clock a. m. on Tuesday at the residence of Mrs. Bray, Twenty-seventh and Terrace avenue.
