**JUVENAL WANTS DAMAGES.**

**He Sues "The Times" for \$25,000 for Slander.**

J. M. Juvenal, who has gained wide notoriety of late by the attempt to blow up his house on the night of August 10, the mysterious death of his wife by poisoning, and his peculiar actions during the trial of the accused Millie Pfaffman, has brought suit against the Kansas City Times, in the circuit court of Kansas City, Mo., for damages in the sum of \$25,000. Malicious slander is alleged. The cause for action is the publication in the paper, September 25, of an article stating that Juvenal met his divorced wife in Topeka, the day previous, and again that he was seen to leave with her for Excelsior Springs, on Saturday last. These statements, it is alleged, are under present circumstances, very damaging.
