

PREPARING FOR HIS DEFENSE.

Banker A. W. Little Places His Property Under Mortgage to Meet the Expenses of His Trial for Murder.

Banker A. W. Little has already begun to make financial preparations for his coming trial on the charge of murdering Lawyer B. E. Johnston. In the office of the register of deeds yesterday afternoon two instruments were filed bearing the signature of A. W. Little and wife. One was a mortgage covering property in Armourdale, Riverview and Bonner Springs to secure a note of \$15,000, payable in three years hence, to J. W. McNeil, of Guthrie, Ok., Mr. Little's partner in the bank business at that place. The other covers a lot of city property, and is to make good the sum of \$5,000 in favor of C. F. Hutchings, H. D. Morse and Henry McGrew, the attorneys engaged by Mr. Little to defend him.
