

THE STARR GANG BOLD.

Open Boasts of a Gang Made up of Appliances From Coffeyville, Kas.

COFFEYVILLE, Kas., May 11.—The Starr gang of eight men was seen two miles east of Caney yesterday evening, and, fearing an attack on the Denver, Memphis & Atlantic train, a strong guard was taken on at Sedan. No attack, however, was made.

Starr and two of his men were at Nowata Tuesday getting horses shod and the leader said that they would have to make another haul, as they were running short of money. It is reported that Bill Dalton is in the gang, but this is not generally believed, for he is thought not to have enough nerve.

It is thought here that the outlaws were supplied with ammunition from here yesterday evening, as cartridges were sold by one of the hardware stores and an Indian showed a lot of them when he rode out of town, in company with three men about five miles out and, after talking with them, returned here.

The brother of Starr's sweetheart was in town this week and says there are fifty-six men in the gang, but this is considered mere boasting.
