

IS HE A DALTON BANDIT?

A Stranger, Full of Bullet Holes, Captured in Atchison.

ATCHISON, KAN., June 2.—About midnight last night Deputy Sheriffs Smith and Donelson arrested a stranger giving his name as George W. Davis for the theft of two grips some time ago. Davis is in a bad way. He has four bullet wounds on his person, any one of which would have killed an ordinary person. He has been shot through the back and lungs, through the shoulder, through the thigh and through the face.

Davis, who had been drinking, when asked how he came by his wounds, said he was in the Dalton fight at Coffeyville. It is believed by the officers that they have captured the missing participant in the famous Dalton raid at Coffeyville last fall, as he tallies with the descriptive card received shortly after the fatal raid.
