

## DALTON'S GANG HARD UP.

**People in the Territory Expect Another  
Raid Very Soon.**

PERRY, Ok., Nov. 13.—Every once in a while some town reports that Bill Dalton was there the night before, coming in and talking with a friend between midnight and dawn, or something of the sort to indicate his presence. To scores of people in this new section of Oklahoma, deputy marshals and others, who know Dalton and his ways, these reports are absurd. They unite in saying that Dalton never exposes himself in any such way, and that the reports are pure fakes.

Dalton now has about six followers. Since the Ingalls fight Dalton has been seen several times by men who know him, but never in any town. A deputy marshal who was on Dalton's trail for a year prior to the Coffeyville affair says that the gang is very hard up and that another raid will soon occur somewhere. Some maintain that the gang is down about Stillwater, others that it has gone west near the New Mexico line. All, however, expect to hear from it again, and before many weeks.
