THREE ARTFUL DODGERS.

Alleged Election Law Violators Who Cannot Be Found.

No arrests have yet been made for violation of the election laws. The only warrants which have been issued are for "Frenchy," "Slim" Smith and "Pinky" Blitz—otherwise L. R. Baker, Charles Campbell and Pink Blitz—and none of these can be found. Baker is said to have gone to New York and Blitz and Campbell have both proven such artful dodgers that the United States deputy marshals have no idea where they are.

Jefferson Brumback of the citizens' committee this morning said that his committee had not yet fixed upon the time for visiting the office of Recorder Owsley to go over the books, but that an early date would probably be named. The committee has two clerks at work preparing the evidence. When this is done the committee will call upon Recorder Owsley for his explanation. It is proposed to examine particularly into the cases of the 2,000 or more legal voters who were not allowed to vote on election day.

Frederick W. Griffin, who will present to the federal grand jury independent of the citizens' committee some evidence concerning frauds, will have it completed soon.
