"PINKY" BLITZ IN JAIL.

**The Election Repeater Awaiting Action on
a Motion for a New Trial.**

"Pinky" Blitz, who, much to the surprise of himself and the "push," was convicted of illegal voting in the United States district court yesterday, is behind the bars in the county jail to-day. His case is now in the hands of Attorney E. H. Stiles, who will to-morrow file a motion for a new trial alleging the usual grounds. Sentence will not be passed upon Blitz until the motion for a new trial is disposed of by Judge Philips. The lower strata of the "push" is dismayed at Blitz's sentence, but it has come to the conclusion that the methods it has been accustomed to use in justice's and other courts do not win in the federal courts.
