HOW "PINKY" AND ROLLA LEFT.

Policemen Cited to Explain the Disappearance of Two Men.

H. T. Clark, patrol wagon conductor, and Herman Fuiks, turnkey at police headquarters, were cited yesterday by the police board to appear Wednesday and explain the disappearance of Rolla Noble and "Pinky" Blitz from the patrol wagon on the night of March 8. They were arrested in a pool hall raid and loaded into the wagon by the arresting officers with several other prisoners. But when the men were lined up before the booking desk Rolla and "Pinky" were missing. They appeared at the station the next day and explained that when the wagon was unloaded in the dark they were mistaken for spectators and told by the policemen to "beat it."
