THE boat which Capt. George Keith is maneuvering along the Ohio to get built will be one of the best money-making craft ever placed in the Missouri, and will be a good one for the Southern trade in the fall. She is to be a strongly built sternwheeler of about 1,500 tons, length 200 feet, beam 42 feet, with 3 boilers, and cylinders 6½ feet stroke, 20 inches diameter.
