

The Steamer Dakotah Sunk To-Day Near Providence, Mo.

Information was received at a late hour to-day of the sinking of the steamer Dakotah, commanded by Capt. George Keith. No particulars were received, but Messrs. Jenkins & Sass, the boat's agents, said she sank just this side of Providence, Mo. The boat was on her up trip on the Missouri River, and had but a light freight load.* Hunter Ben Jenkins was half owner, Commodore Carlson of Yankton, Dak., owns three-eighths and John Hermann of Alton the remainder. She was insured for \$15,000 and valued at \$24,000. It is not known whether the Dakotah can be raised or not.
