But That Is as Far as Winner Bridge Project Has Gone, Says K.

Plans for the Winner bridge have been drawn up by the Theodore Bates syndicate and have been approved at Washington. This, however, is as far as the syndicate has gone or is likely to go any time soon.

Mr. Kenneth McC. DeWeese who, together with Thomas R. Morrow, represents the Bates interests in Kansas City, said yesterday that neither he nor Mr. Morrow had any idea when the bridge would be built, if ever.

"If it were near at hand," he said, "we would certainly know it. There will be no bridge there, certainly, until there is a greater demand for it than there is now."
